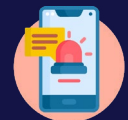

NSW STATE EMERGENCY SERVICE

NSW State Emergency Service (SES) is an emergency and rescue service dedicated to assisting the community. They are a volunteer-based organisation that provides emergency assistance to the people of NSW 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year.

Their services include responses to:
flood and storm emergencies,
road accidents
vertical rescue
bush searches.



NSW SES assists NSW Police Force, the NSW Rural Fire Service, Fire and Rescue NSW and the Ambulance Service of NSW.

How to use SES as a resource

1. Follow them on social media - Fairfield and Liverpool have Facebook pages. Evacuation updates can be received here.
2. Look at the resources on their website: evacuation, flood in language resources, Fire and rescue advice, evacuation centres and more.
3. Details about evacuation centres
4. Understanding your risk of flood based on the area you live in.
